02 NCAC 31C .0103 WRITTEN STATEMENT ON CANDIDATE

(a) The sponsor of the nominee submits a written statement (three copies) outlining as completely as possible the work of the candidate and evidence of its effect on the agricultural life of the state.

- (b) The statement should also cover the biography of the person including the following:
 - (1) his or her personality,
 - (2) successes and failures,
 - (3) obstacles overcome,
 - (4) any other information that would be of interest to the reader.

(c) The statement should be primarily in narrative form and the style attractive.
