04 NCAC 20A .0103 FUNCTIONS AND LOCATION OF THE DIVISION

- (a) The functions of the Division are:
 - (1) To administer federal grants awarded to the Governor under federal employment and training legislation, including JTPA;
 - (2) To provide staff for the State Job Training Coordinating Council and such other councils as required by federal law;
 - (3) To provide administrative and information services to subgrantees and division contractors to conduct employment and training activities;
 - (4) To manage programs and resources, through written agreements with subgrantees and contractors to carry out employment and training policies and activities;
 - (5) To perform functions, as the delegate of the Governor, reserved for the Governor in the Job Training Partnership Act;
 - (6) To promote efficient management and coordination of job training programs in order to maximize the benefits of these programs to the citizens of North Carolina; and
 - (7) To promote an active, effective partnership between local and state agencies and private business in providing job training.
- (b) The location and mailing address of the Division's main office is 111 Seaboard Avenue, Raleigh, North Carolina 27604.
- (c) Nothing in this Section shall be considered to limit the reasonable functioning of the Division or to restrict the location of division offices.
