07 NCAC 03B .0204 EXHIBITIONS

- (a) The museum may hold competitions for which members of the public who meet specified residency or other requirements may be invited to submit works of art executed by themselves for exhibition in the museum or other locations.
- (b) Selection of works for inclusion in the exhibition will be made by one or more jurors chosen by the museum. The competitions may be staged in conjunction with other organizations and may be held at intervals set by the museum.
- (c) A prospectus containing information about rules will be published for each competition. The submission of an entry to the competition will be considered an agreement on the part of the artist to the conditions set forth in the prospectus.
