## 07 NCAC 03B .0506 OUTSIDE SERVICES

- (a) Requests by public and private organizations for museum staff members to serve as jurors for competitive exhibitions, lecturers, or consultants will be granted at the discretion of the museum on the basis of the nature of the event and the availability of qualified staff members.
- (b) No fee other than travel and per diem expenses at rates established under state rules may be required for such service when performed under the auspices of the museum.
- (c) Museum staff members are permitted to provide such outside services on their own time, provided it is made clear that the staff member is acting individually and not as a representative of the museum or of state government. Any financial arrangements will be negotiated directly between the individual and the organization requesting the service.
