10 NCAC 26E .0119 CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION: DENIAL OF REGISTRATION

- (a) The director shall issue a certificate of registration (Commission for Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Services Form 223) to an applicant if the issuance of registration or re-registration is required under the applicable provisions of G.S. 90-102. Before denying any application, the director shall issue an order to show cause pursuant to Rule .0121 of this Section and shall hold a hearing on the application pursuant to Rule .0122 of this Section. (b) The certificate of registration (Commission for Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Services Form 223) shall contain the name, address and registration number of the registrant, the activity authorized by the registration, the schedules or Drug Enforcement Administration controlled substances code number of the controlled substances which the registrant is authorized to handle and the expiration date of the registration.
- (c) The registrant shall maintain the certificate of registration at the registered location in a readily retrievable manner and shall permit inspection of the certificate by an official, agent or employee of the Department of Health and Human Services or any federal or state agency engaged in enforcement of laws relating to controlled substances.
