## 10A NCAC 63F .0625 RECORD

(a) The official records of impartial due process hearings shall be maintained in the central office of the Division.(b) Any person wishing to examine a hearing record shall submit a written request to the Director in sufficient time to allow the record to be prepared for inspection, including the removal of any confidential material.
