21 NCAC 50. 0318 LICENSE IN GOOD STANDING

A license has been maintained in good standing for the purposes of G.S. 87-21(b)(3) if the license:

- (1) has remained continuously active for 10 years as of the date of the application request;
- (2) is current as to all fees payable to the Board as of the date of the application request; and
- has not been the subject of a disciplinary order that imposed a sanction that included supervised probation, suspension, revocation or restoration of a revoked license during the 10-year period preceding the date of the application request for a Class II plumbing or heating license.
