

21 NCAC 64 .0307 GOOD MORAL CONDUCT

In addition to the Proscriptions in this Section, licensees shall engage in good moral conduct under all conditions of professional activity. "Good moral conduct" shall be defined as conduct in keeping with the Code of Ethics of American Speech-Language-Hearing Association in effect as of January 1, 2013, specifically: Principle of Ethics I, Rules of Ethics Q and Principles of Ethics IV, Rules of Ethics D and E.
