

02 NCAC 48A .0205 INTERSTATE SHIPMENT

- (a) North Carolina bees will be inspected within a reasonable time for beekeepers desiring an inspection as a prerequisite for interstate shipment of bees. There is no charge for this service. The inspection will be made only at a time of year when there is some brood rearing activity in a majority of the colonies.
- (b) Health certificates will be issued according to the provisions of these rules.
- (c) The State Apiarist may charge the additional costs of making inspections when the beekeeper requests inspection at a specified time for his own convenience and there is not adequate time for normal routine scheduling of the inspection.
