02 NCAC 52K .0301 SIGNAGE

An animal contact exhibit shall provide visible signage at the entrance and exit of the exhibit to educate the public regarding:

- (1) the fact that animal contact may pose a health risk;
- (2) items that are prohibited in animal areas;
- (3) the identity of high risk populations, including:
 - (a) the elderly;
 - (b) children under the age of six;
 - (c) women who are pregnant;
 - (d) people with an existing health condition; and
- (4) the location of hand-washing stations.
