

27 NCAC 01D .1907 ACCREDITATION OF SPONSOR

(a) The following is the list of accredited sponsors:

- (2) North Carolina Academy of Trial Lawyers;
- (3) Wake Forest University Continuing Legal Education;
- (4) University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill Continuing Legal Education;
- (5) Duke University School of Law Continuing Legal Education;
- (6) Norman Adrian Wiggins School of Law Continuing Legal Education;
- (7) Middle District Bankruptcy Seminar;
- (8) UCB Estate Planning and Taxation Seminar;
- (9) any member of the Association of Continuing Legal Education Administrators;
- (10) University of Miami School of Law;

If, in the judgment of the board, the sponsor has met the accreditation standards of Rule .1903 of this Section for each of the courses offered, the board will designate the sponsor as an accredited sponsor.
